

2022-2023 HOST GYM INFORMATION (BASKETBALL)

ADMISSIONS & CONCESSIONS - The host school may, but is not required to charge an admission fee to basketball games. This admission fee may not exceed \$3.00 for adults, \$2.00 for high school students and Seniors over 65, and \$1.00 for grade school children. Revenues realized from admissions and concessions remain in the treasury of the host gym.

SCORER'S TABLE - The host school must make certain that qualified personnel are administering the game clock and the scorebook for every basketball game. These personnel must be familiar with the operation of all score table equipment and must be at least high school age students. In addition to running the game clock and keeping the official scorebook, personnel at the scorer's table are responsible for the alternate possession arrow or light.

EQUIPMENT - The host gym is to provide the official leather game basketballs in proper size for both boys and girls games. The host gym is also required to provide at least two (2) practice/warm-up basketballs for each team. The host gym must have back-up jerseys (or cover-ups) available for games involving teams wearing the same-colored uniform. In addition, a first aid kit, cold packs, or ice are to be readily available in case of injury.

2022-23 BASKETBALL RULES - A copy of the Parkview basketball rules are to be kept at the scorer's table at all times.

UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT / COMPLAINT FORMS - Forms are to be kept at the scorer's table so that they can be provided to both officials and coaches in order to file formal complaints or report unsportsmanlike conduct. In either case, the form must be filled out, signed, and forwarded to the Parkview Basketball Director within seven (7) days of the event in order for action to be taken.

SCHEDULES - The host gym is responsible for reviewing their schedules and making certain that adequate personnel are available for all scheduled games.

SUPERVISION - Host gym is responsible for supervising the public area in and around their building at all times during the scheduled events.

SCORES - Game scores are to be sent via E-Mail to the league no later than 10:00 P.M. Sunday evening. The email address is rol7033@yahoo.com Gyms may call in the scores to (414-640-5837). However, the league would prefer that all schools switch over to the e-mail method.
